Cape Borda Lighthouse

Since its opening on 13 July 1858, the Cape Borda lightstation has been an important landmark on South Australia's coast. It marks the north-west end of Kangaroo Island and the entrance to Investigator Strait. For many years, it was the first light in South Australian waters sighted by ships sailing from the west.
