2-4 **2010 Kangaroo Island Planting Festival 2-4 July 2010**

The festival is three days of intensive planting activity to help restore the habitat of Kangaroo Island's rarest plant life. Over the three days 80,000 plants will be planted and 40kg of seed spread to reinstate over 40 ha of threatened plant habitat in the highly cleared lower Cygnet Valley on Kangaroo Island.
